



MODERN ROCKING HORSE

GIVE A BLAND ROCKING HORSE AN UPDATED LOOK

Use Rust-Oleum® Painter's Touch+ to bring life to a dull rocking horse. Add bright colours and fun finishes to transform your rocking horse into a playful piece for children.

Items

- Rust-Oleum Painter's Touch+ Gloss Rose Petal spray paint
- Rust-Oleum Painter's Touch+ Aluminium spray paint
- Rust-Oleum Painter's Touch+ Primer Spray
- Rocking horse
- Drop cloth
- Lint-free cloth
- Painter's tape
- Large plastic bag

STEPS

- 1. PREPARE:** Always work in a well-ventilated area. Cover nearby items with a drop cloth to protect from spray mist. Clean surfaces with a lint-free cloth.
- 2. PAINT: Rocking Horse:** Shake can of Painter's Touch+ Flat White Primer spray for 1 minute after the mixing ball begins to rattle. Hold can upright 25-40cm from surface and spray in a steady back-and-forth motion, slightly overlapping each stroke. Apply two or more light coats a few minutes apart. Once primer is dried, apply Painter's Touch+ Gloss Rose Petal to rocking horse. Hold can upright 25-40cm from surface and spray in a steady back-and-forth motion, slightly overlapping each stroke. Apply two or more light coats a few minutes apart to avoid drips and runs. **Handles:** Once dry, cover the entire horse with a plastic bag, exposing only the handles of the Rocking Horse. Use painter's tape to secure the bag around the handles. Take Painter's Touch+ Aluminium spray paint and hold can upright 25-40cm from surface and spray in a steady back-and-forth motion, slightly overlapping each stroke. Apply two or more light coats a few minutes apart.
- 3. FINISH:** Remove plastic bag, and allow to dry for 24 hours before handling.
